Dr Holtz studied mathematics and business administration at the universities of Bonn and Toronto. After graduating, he completed a PhD on rapid computer algorithms for banks and insurance companies at the University of Bonn. He is the author of several articles and of a book on mathematical quadrature methods, which was published by Springer Verlag in 2011. In early 2009, he began working in risk management at the Baloise Group, where he was mainly responsible for valuation and risk measurement methods for life insurance. Alongside his work, he also completed his training as an actuary and has been a member of the Swiss Association of Actuaries since 2012. He became Investor Relations Manager at the Baloise Group in 2016, since when he has been responsible for supporting analysts and investors at Baloise and for the Group's related reporting. He also oversees the Standard & Poor's rating process and is involved in the Group's corporate finance and value management projects.
